Parent/Child Program Enrollment Agreement
Session 1: September 12, 2011 – November 4, 2011 (8 weeks)

- 1) Enrollment in the Parent/Child Program is contingent upon payment in advance of all fees and receipt of this signed agreement; families will not be considered enrolled in the program unless fees have been paid in full and this agreement has been signed by the Parent/Guardian(s).
- 2) The Participation Fee in this parent/child session is **\$240.00** per child, which includes a **\$75** nonrefundable deposit due by June 30, 2009.
- 3) Payments are made to the Sacramento Waldorf School and can be paid by cash, credit card or check. A 2.5% convenience fee will be added to all credit card payments.
- 4) Parent/Guardian(s) are/is required to provide primary health insurance for each enrolled student at their/his/her own cost. In addition, the School provides a secondary Student Accident Insurance policy.
- 5) Children with a sibling's in the program will receive a 20% discount
- 6) Fees for each session must be paid in full one week before the session begins. Families will be prevented from attending the program if their fees have not been paid. Families are entitled to a full refund of the fee for each session provided they have notified the school in writing of their withdrawal before the start of the second class of the session. Refunds will be honored within 30 days of the withdrawal notification.
- 7) Registration for each session of the Parent/Child Program covers the entire session. There is accordingly no discount, refund or other allowance for absence, illness, dismissal or withdrawal, whether by the parent's choice or at the school's request, except as described in section 4 above.
- 8) Participation in this program is limited to one adult and one child aged six months to three years per enrollment fee. Siblings younger than six months may attend class with the family, subject to teacher permission.
- 9) Families will be issued a schedule for each session in advance by the teacher. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that all participants arrive for class on time and ready to participate. Families who arrive late or unprepared to class may be prevented from participating in class for that day. Additionally, parents are advised that children enrolled in the Parent/Child program may not be on school property unless accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
- 10) It is strongly recommended that parents and children wear loose, comfortable clothing and carry a change of clothing for children; families may be prevented from participating in certain activities if they are not properly dressed.
- 11) Snacks may be provided when appropriate, and may include wheat and dairy products. It is the responsibility of the parents to notify the school if a child has allergies, and provide alternative snacks for the child to eat if necessary.
- 12) Parent/Guardian(s) agree(s) to provide the School with a completed health form and any necessary student record forms as shall be required by the School or any duly constituted federal, state or local authority.
- 13) Parent/Guardian(s) agree(s) to withdraw from the program immediately upon the school's request. Voluntary withdrawal from the program must be noticed in writing to the school.
- 14) Participation in the Sacramento Waldorf School Parent & Child Program is an appropriate introduction to Waldorf education and an excellent preparation for our Kindergarten, however, a separate application is required for Kindergarten and acceptance is not guaranteed.
- 15) Parent/Guardian(s) hereby authorize(s) and give(s) full consent to Sacramento Waldorf School to publish and copyright all photos in which the family appears and taken while enrolled in any and all programs. Continued use does not constitute an agreement to continue the family's enrollment.
- 16) The Parent/Guardian(s) agree(s) to release and hold harmless, the School, its employees, trustees and agents from all claims, damages or other liabilities for injuries to their child which are not the result of gross negligence by this School, its agents or employees. The Parent/Guardian(s) also agree(s) to pay the School for any damages or loss by their child to the School or School property. The School is not responsible for damage to or theft of personal property on School premises.
- 17) Parent/Guardian(s) have read and understood all provisions of this agreement and acknowledge responsibility for all relevant provisions hereof.
